

VOTER INFORMATION

WHO MAY VOTE?

- U.S. Citizens at least 18 years old on election day.
- Registered to vote in the county, city or district holding the election at least 30 days prior to the election.
- Not a convicted felon or declared mentally incapacitated by court of law.

WHERE DO I VOTE?

- On election day, vote at the site assigned to your precinct.
- Voting locations are listed in local newspapers during the early voting period and on election day.
- Go to www.epcounty.com/elections and click on "Personalized Voter Info" in left column.

HOW TO REGISTER TO VOTE

- Pick up an application at the public libraries, drivers' license bureaus or contact the Elections Office or the League of Women Voters

WHEN TO REGISTER

- Applications are accepted at any time.
- Only those applications received 30 days prior to an election can vote in that election.

HOW TO UPDATE YOUR VOTER REGISTRATION

- If you move within a county or wish to make a name change, correct the information on your card and send to the Elections Office. Alternatively, you may contact the Elections Office for a change information form.
- If you move to another county or have just moved from another county, re-register in the new county of residence.
- Changes must be completed 30 days prior to an election to be able to vote in a new precinct.

HOW TO VOTE EARLY

- Registered voters may vote at any designated early polling site within the county, city or district calling the election.
- Early voting begins 17 days and ends 4 days prior to election day.

HOW TO VOTE ABSENTEE BY MAIL

- Registered voters may apply between 60 days and 7 days prior to an election. Contact the Elections Office.
- Ballots must be returned by 7 pm on election day.

WHO MAY VOTE ABSENTEE BY MAIL?

- Registered voter absent from the county, city or district during the early voting period and on election day.
- Registered voter with a disability.
- Registered voter who is 65 or older on election day.
- Registered voter who is confined to jail but otherwise eligible.

WHICH OFFICIALS REPRESENT MY PRECINCT?

- Unless precinct numbers are listed for an office, they represent all 173 precincts in the county (except for the larger school districts).

WHAT IS MY PRECINCT?

- On the left half of a Voter Registration Certificate, the precinct number is in the middle box in the second row of boxes. The boxes on the right side give the district or precinct number for your U.S. Representative, State Senator, State Representative, County Commissioner, Justice of the Peace, City Representative, School District, and EPCC District.
